



Vocabulary: Acquisition and Use

Student RIT: Your child's scaled score for a given test session

and Structure

- District Grade Level Mean RIT: The average RIT score for students in the same school district and grade, tested at the same time
- Norm Grade Level Mean RIT: The average RIT score for students in the same grade, same time based on the national NWEA norms
- Student RIT Projection: Your child's projected score based on your child's RIT and the average growth of students with the same RIT as observed on the NWEA RIT norms
- 5. Goals Performance: Each tested area includes goal areas, that include a descriptive adjective
- 6. **RIT Range:** The middle number is your child's RIT score. The numbers on either side of the bolded number show where your child may score, if retested soon
- 7. RIT Growth: Shows your child's growth in RIT points between testing periods

Informational Text: Language, Craft,

- 8. **Growth Projection:** Represents the average growth of students with a similar RIT score to your child
- 9. **Percentile:** The bolded number is the national percentile associated with your child's RIT score
- 10. Percentile Range: The numbers on either side of the percentile rank define the percentile range
